



Directions from Atlanta to the Barn and Office at Anderson Creek Retreat

You may reach Anderson Creek Retreat by Georgia 400 or I-75 and Highway 515, the Mountain Parkway. The map on the web at andersoncreekretreat.com is not a road map so do not rely on it.

To Anderson Creek Retreat via Highway 400

From I-285 you will travel north on Georgia 400 approximately 2.3 miles past Highway 53 near Dawsonville. Turn left on Hwy 136 and travel approximately 14 miles until 136 merges with Hwy 183. Continue on Hwy 183 for 2.3 miles until it ends at Highway 52 near Amicalola Falls. Turn left on Hwy 52 toward Ellijay.

At approximately 10.6 miles turn right on Roy Road (Stanley Grocery with a Chevron sign is on your right as well as a white clapboard Methodist Church). Go approximately 5.8 miles on Roy Road to a stop sign at Old Bucktown Road. Turn right across the bridge on Tickantley Creek and bear left on Old Bucktown Road for 1.3 miles. The barn and pasture are on your right at Spring Camp Road.

Via Highway 515

Exit Highway 515 just north of Ellijay on Highway 52. (An easy access to Hwy 52 is to go through three lights (first being the Super Wal-Mart) and as you are leaving Ellijay you will see a sign to the right to loop to Hwy '52. There is also a sign to an Antique Store. Take that exit and when you come to Hwy '52 you will be facing the Antique store. At this point you will turn left traveling east toward Dahlonega approximately 6 miles. At the top of the hill after crossing the Cartecay River, turn left on Roy Road (Chevron sign) and follow the above directions from Stanley's Grocery and the Methodist Church.
